During the orientation of Std. IX to XII, Principal sir briefed the objectives of PTM and introduced the teachers teaching in classes IX to XII. Parents were urged to send healthy lunch box, avoiding junk food and oily food. He laid emphasis on regularity and punctuality among students. Parents were made clear about 75% mandatory attendance , as per CBSE Examination Bye Laws, Promotion policy for class IX and XI, Co-curricular activities and positive attitude towards learning .
PTM – Periodic Test and Term I Exam I to VIII	PTMs were held after the Unit Test and Periodic Test . Principal Sir, Mr. Vaibhav Agarwal and class teachers and subject teachers interacted with the parents and shared the rules and regulars needed for the smooth functioning of the school and also explained about the activities mentioned in the almanac. Teachers suggested the remedies for improvement of the performance of the child like extra reading writing practice, use the dictionary, to revise the topics at home on regular basis, to minimize the use of mobile and to spend leisure time with the child every day.
